

Re: Googong Township Water Recycling Plant - Environment Protection Licence No. 20788 – Request for temporary working hours variation

Dear Julian.

I refer to condition L5.1 Environment Protection Licence (EPL) No. 20788 for scheduled development works associated with the Googong Integrated Water Cycle (IWC) Project which states:

L5.1 Standard working hours

Unless otherwise specified by any other condition of this licence, all construction activities are:

- a) restricted to between the hours of 7:00am and 6:00pm Monday to Friday;
- b) restricted to between the hours of 8:00am and 1:00pm Saturday; and
- c) not to be undertaken on Sundays or Public Holidays.

GTPL's contractors have requested extended working hours of 7:00am to 5:00pm Saturday and Sunday whilst Reservoir Installation works are taking place. This is to enable the most efficient installation of the Glass-Fused-to-Steel Reservoir Panels. Installation has now commenced and is expected to be completed at the end of June 2017. The works proposed to be undertaken during these extended hours will be limited to the installation of Glass-Fused-to-Steel Panels with the use of a forklift, and securing of the panels with hand tools. There will be no earthworks or additional deliveries during the proposed extended working hours. It is expected that a maximum of 10 employees will be onsite during this time.

GTPL is therefore seeking a temporary licence variation of EPL 20788 for revised working hours of 7:00am to 5:00pm Saturday and Sunday to ensure timely installation of the new reservoirs. No change is requested for currently approved working hours Monday to Friday.
