The hot and dry conditions this summer have meant that construction works have progressed well.

However, the weather has also resulted in newly planted street trees and some grass areas showing the effects of the heat and dry winds. Googong and Queanbeyan City Council (QCC) are working together to keep these areas watered. If you're already living at Googong, you can help the young landscape in the street outside your home by watering it when you have the chance.

Subdivision Stages 5A (67 lots), 6A (68) and 5B (85) were recently registered and registration of Stage 6D is imminent. This brings the total number of completed blocks in Googong North to 1050 and works are underway on a further 350 lots in Stages Neighbourhood 1B Stages 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5.

Rockley Oval, which has already built a reputation for being one of the best sporting fields in Queanbeyan, will soon be prepared for winter with an over sow of a winter grass. Once established, the oval will play host to the Googong Hogs and Queanbeyan Tiger's Junior AFL teams.



At Duncan Fields, the pavilion, sports surface and playground are complete. The planned handover to Council will take place in May 2016 for the start of the soccer season – which also happens to be the debut season for the Googong Panthers. (Go Panthers!)

The planting of street trees and construction of parks across stages 5A, 5B and 6A are well advanced with tree planting complete in Stage 5. The exciting new playgrounds at Aprasia Park and Lovegrove Park (pictured below) are well underway, with handover to Council expected in June 2016.



The Development Application for the township's first shopping centre in Googong North is progressing as Council continue with their assessment. Works should commence in mid 2016 and the first shops and childcare facilities are anticipated to be open in mid 2017.

The first Terraces by Googong are now under construction and are starting to take shape. This represents an important milestone for Googong as more compact homes become available for our residents.

The verification phase of the water recycling plant is going well with the plant meeting all performance requirements. All going well, the plant will be providing recycled water to the township by June this year. Tenders have closed for the township's permanent water supply reservoirs to service the rapidly growing population. Construction is expected to commence in May 2016 and be complete by mid 2017.



Sales remain very strong with the successful second release of Montgomery Rise, and Googong remains extremely good value – especially when compared to the soaring land prices in the ACT.

As always, the school welcomes visitors to their various Open Days throughout the year, or by appointment at other times. They're proud of their students, and are keen to show off the school, and demonstrate 'Googong Learning' in action.



Planning is already underway for the school's first Year 7 students, with classes to commence in 2018. Recently, the school spoke with around 50 current and future parents about the aspirations they have for their children and the type of school they believe would best prepare them for a world of work in the 2030s.

The final testing of the Water Recycling Plant is almost finished, meaning the supply of recycled water to Googong is getting very close! So now's a great time to familiarise yourself with what you can and can't use recycled water for – see below.

What you CAN use recycled water for:	What you CAN'T use recycled water for:
✓ Flushing toilets	Drinking
✓ Watering lawns and gardens	✗ Cooking and other kitchen uses
✓ Washing cars, brickworks and windows	Bathing (bath, showers, hand basins)
✓ Fighting fires	Fillings pools and spas
✓ Watering sportsfields and parks	✗ Cooling systems
✓ Watering your fruit and vegetable gardens*	✗ Hot water systems
*As a safeguard ensure that all fruit and vegetables watered with recycled water are washed prior to eating	Playing (sprinklers, filling water toys)
