GOOGONG'S PROJECT DIRECTOR

Hello again, Googong!

A lot has happened since our last update, so let's take a look at how our town has grown. I'm pleased to say, there's plenty of great news to share with you all.

- Neighbourhood 2 Stages 1 and 2 have now been completed. It's another big milestone for the township!
- **Googong now has 1,290 occupied homes** with a further 200 under construction.
- Building work on Googong's next display village is about to begin. Located in Neighbourhood 2: Stage 2, the new village comprises 19 homes from 15 builders – so once again, Googong will be home to the largest display village in the region. It's scheduled to open March 2020.
- Neighbourhood 2: Stage 3 is under construction. This stage includes:
 - the second (and main) entry to Googong from Old Cooma Road
 - the upgrade of the intersection of Old Cooma Road and Googong Road, and
 - the upgrade of Old Cooma Road between the two intersections.

This is an exciting step in Googong's development will see significant tree planting and a rather striking upgrade to the town entry that will really impress. In addition to this, you'll see a series of landscape features (including a major pedestrian bridge) built along Wellsvale Drive, providing a welcoming entry to the town for Googonians and visitors alike.

- Structure Planning of Neighbourhoods 3, 4 and 5 (Googong West, South and East) is nearing completion with submission to QPRC anticipated in late June. QPRC's approval process will include public notification and consideration of comments from the community.
- The process of finding a new owner for Club Googong continues. We expect to be announcing a new owner/ operator within the next couple of months.
- Construction of the Googong Common North sports and recreation precinct is planned for September 2019. Expect to see established in the first stage of development:
 - six outdoor netball courts
 - a temporary bike pump track
 - boardwalks across Montgomery Creek linking the sports precinct with the existing path system within the Common,
 - BBQ and amenity facilities, and
 - an off-street parking area.



- The first stage of the Smart Cities Initiative at Googong has commenced.
 - The smart lighting is being installed along Old Cooma Road will reduce electricity consumption in the street lighting by up to 50%.
 - A smart pole will be trialled within the Courtney Street park. It will run the irrigation system via solar and wind power; establish the first of a network of environmental sensors at Googong; and also have the potential to offer public Wi-Fi in this area.
 - As works along Wellsvale Drive and Googong Common progress additional smart technologies will be installed to improve community connection and Council's management of assets.
- Environmental work has slowed down with the onset of Winter. However, Googong Landcare are continuing with their stewardship of the environment, focussing on the revegetation planting on Nangi Pimble. Together with Molonglo Conservation Group, we're developing a programme of environmentally focused works for later in the year.
