A message from Malcolm

GOOGONG'S PROJECT DIRECTOR

Given the situation with COVID-19 we want to let you know we are committed to supporting the health, safety and wellbeing of everyone at Googong including residents, customers, builders, visitors and staff. Your wellbeing remains our highest priority, which is why we are continually monitoring the latest Federal and State Government advice and taking steps to put in place necessary changes.

We currently remain open for business and are here to support our customers and residents during this challenging time.

Development is proceeding with the necessary precautions recommended by Government and Health Authorities, but progress will no doubt be affected by the impacts of COVID-19.

Googong's new main entry road, Wellsvale Drive, is complete and is expected to open in April 2020 pending final approvals. In the coming months, a major entry statement will be installed on the intersection of Wellsvale Drive and Old Cooma Road. The feature will be constructed from precast concrete and rusted steel (corten steel), will be approximately 18m wide, 6.5m tall and be lit at night with colour changing LED lights.



The Wellsvale Drive entrance statement will be completed in the coming months.

Construction of the new display village showcasing innovations in home design continues in Courtney Street, and is due to open progressively from April 2020. We have recently relocated our sales office from Club Googong to a temporary building within the new display village, which we opened on 4 April 2020.



DJ Homes is the first of our 19-home display village to open.

Construction within the Googong Common North sports and recreation precinct is well underway with completion due mid-2020. The first stage of development within this precinct will see the establishment of six outdoor netball courts, a public toilet block, a temporary bike pump track, boardwalks across Montgomery Creek linking the

sports precinct with the existing path system within the Common, BBQ facilities and off-street parking.

The associated carpark is nearing completion and is surfaced with a product called Reconophalt, Australia's first asphalt product that contains high recycled content from materials such as soft plastics, glass, toner and reclaimed roads.

A kilometre of road (two lanes) paved with Reconophalt can contain 500,000 plastic bags and packaging equivalents, 165,000 glass bottle equivalents and toner from 12,000 used printer cartridges. The carpark will serve as a trial for the product in the hope that it can be used more widely on the remaining roads at Googong.





Reconophalt is a road surface product made from recycled materials, and is being installed at the netball courts in Googong.

The Googong Township / Molonglo Conservation Group \$1m co-funded Pink-tailed Worm Lizard Saving our Species initiative is underway with the installation of a perimeter fence to start soon. Mapping of the species has been completed which will allow solid works planning going forward over the remaining 5 years of this project. These works include establishing or improving habitat for the species in specific areas, weed management, native grass improvement and creating an education sanctuary with the installation of walking trails which will be used by the Molonglo Conservation Group for guided tours.

The final stage of the PTWL Conservation area has been established and is currently undergoing a development application. Rock relocation of specific rocks (favoured by the PTWL for hiding under) into the conservation area to encourage population growth for the species and the southern boundary fence are complete. Once the DA determination is complete, the conservation zone will be gifted to council.

Googonians will have noticed construction fences installed around basins along the township's eastern margin. These basins have been intensively managed as temporary sediment retention basins by Googong while residential construction was at its highest. As residential construction nears completion across the catchment, Googong will convert and establish these basins to their permanent form as a biofiltration basin. You will have noticed the work on the basins has been infrequent due to the wettest start of a year Googong has had since commencing on site in 2013 – but of course we're not complaining about the drought breaking!

We welcome the exciting news from John Barilaro on behalf of the NSW Government that it is commencing preliminary works for the development of a new primary school in Googong. With more than 4,500 people living in this thriving new town, the development of the community's second school is an important milestone.

The public primary school – and the public high school which is yet to be developed – will complement
The Anglican School Googong which opened in 2015 and is currently taking enrolments from Early Learning to
Year 9, with projections to grow each year to year 12 by 2023.

This announcement highlights the options residents will have when they raise their families in the community.





GOOGONG INTEGRATED WATER CYCLE PROJECT INVITATION TO COMMENT ON THE STAGE D EXPANSION WORKS

We are inviting you to comment on the next component (Stage D) of Googong's Integrated Water Cycle project.

Googong's Integrated Water Cycle system is designed to deliver recycled water to every home in the township for toilet flushing and garden watering, as well as providing irrigation for parks and open spaces. Our aim is to reduce potable water consumption by over 60% compared to a typical development.

Stages A, B and C of the project are complete and have been handed over to Queanbeyan-Palerang Regional Council for operation. We are now starting the planning and approvals for Stage D, which includes the preparation of a Review of Environmental Factors.

The proposed works for Stage D includes an upgrade of the existing water recycling plant located on Googong Dam Road and installation of a new concrete reservoir tank to hold the recycled water at the existing site on Old Cooma Road.

This is another step towards a more sustainable and low environmental impact Googong community.
