# A message from Malcolm GOOGONG'S PROJECT DIRECTOR

Demand for land at Googong continues to be strong. Our team is gearing up to accelerate the construction of roads and services so these new Googonians can build their new homes as soon as possible. Construction of NH2 Stage 5 5B and NH1A Stage 4D were recently completed and construction has commenced in NH2 Stages 6, 8, 9, 10 and 12.

Detailed planning of the future neighbourhoods of Googong is well underway, with a development application to be lodged in August 2021. Landscape work is now complete on a new local park within Neighbourhood 2 Stage 5. The park includes a small shelter, circular path (great for learning how to ride), kick-about area, smart bins, and solar lights with a self-dimming function.



Work on the latest sporting field, sports field 3, has commenced and will likely open early in the new year. It is primarily an AFL field but has been designed to enable a cricket pitch to be retrofitted in future. The works also includes concrete terrace seating with an undercover portion, flood lights and all-accessible path connections.

The Googong Smart City deployment is now collecting data to provide insights to council

on how to best service Googonian needs through initiatives, such as improved public waste management. A Googong Smart City App has also been developed and is available on Google Play and the App Store. The app has been developed to provide information and services to residents. A BBQ booking service is in development and looking to launch in spring. Feel free to download the app and submit any suggestions you have – your feedback will help make it a great app!

You may have noticed the Googong entry statement (Terraformis) lit in different colours over the last few months. The operations team have developed a light show calendar to recognise certain events during the year. This light-hearted initiative is for your enjoyment when coming and going from the township.

Construction of Bunyip Park, including our new permanent sales office, is due to start in July. Bunyip Park will be the 'front door' to Googong's town centre, the planning for which is underway.



Googong was accredited as a 5 star Green Star Community by the Green Building Council of Australia in 2016. The township has recently been through a process of re-accreditation, and I am pleased to say our 5 star accreditation has been confirmed and extended until 2026. This demonstrates we are delivering on the many sustainability initiatives we promised as part of the original certification.

There are now about 1,900 homes occupied, with the population standing at around 6,000.

#### Member for Monaro John Barilaro recently announced that Hansen Yuncken has been awarded the early design contract for Googong's new primary school.

Mr Barilaro said the announcement marked a significant milestone in the delivery of the new school.

"It's exciting to think that in the very near future, students will be walking through the doors of this new primary school in Googong," Mr Barilaro said.

"By getting Hansen Yuncken involved in this early phase, this new school will be delivered with a quick turnaround.

"This is an exciting project for Googong — providing a much-needed new school, boasting world class facilities to serve some of our littlest learners for many years to come.

"I'm delighted to see the progress at Googong and I'm looking forward to sharing the designs of the new school with the community in the near future." Education Minister Sarah Mitchell said delivery of the project has been fast-tracked as part of the NSW Government's COVID-19 Recovery Plan, providing a new primary school for the community of Googong but also supporting local jobs.

#### "We are working to provide a school that meets the needs of the students in the Googong area and is specifically designed for this community," Ms Mitchell said.

"I want every child in NSW, no matter where they live, to have access to excellent learning facilities and I'm deeply committed to investing in regional and rural schools.

"I'm proud that we are continuing our record investment in school infrastructure."

# GOOGONG POP-UP CRICKET BLAST

The inaugural 'Googong' Woolworths Cricket Blast Centre, run by the Queanbeyan District Junior Cricket Club, ran for 4 weeks during Term 1 at Rockley Oval.

This was a fabulous introduction to cricket for local kids aged between 4 and 10. It was ably delivered by the clubs' older junior players, in collaboration with Cricket NSW.

51 boys and girls participated, a phenomenal result! This highlights the appetite for cricket in the township.

Cricket Blast is the entry level program for the sport and is split into two groups. Junior Blast (5–8yo) is designed to develop cricket skills in fun game-based activities. Master Blast (8–10yo) is played in teams of 6–8 with a soft ball on smaller grounds, in



preparation for Stage 1 Junior Cricket (with a hardball and protective equipment).

Queanbeyan Junior CC will be offering both programs for local Googong kids again next summer while also offering junior cricket for kids 10 and up. Stay tuned for further details as next season approaches.

#### **COVID VACCINATIONS – ASTRAZENECA**

We are now running COVID vaccination clinics for Phase 2a — people 50 years of age and older.

The clinics are open Tuesday mornings from 8.45am – 12.15pm, and all-day on Fridays from 9.45am – 6.30pm.

Appointments are required, to help us minimise wastage of these multi-dose vaccines. Please call the surgery on 5104 9595 to book.

COVID vaccinations are bulk billed to Medicare.

#### **INFLUENZA VACCINATIONS**

All flu vaccines (private and government funded) are in stock for all age groups. Flu vaccinations are bulk billed to Medicare.

If you do not qualify for the government funded vaccine, the cost of the vaccine is \$15.

#### **PLEASE NOTE:**

- There must be at least 14 days between your flu vaccination and your COVID vaccination.
- Your second COVID vaccination will be done 12 weeks following the original one.

Following administration of either vaccine, you will need to wait at the surgery for 15 minutes to ensure any adverse reactions are appropriately addressed.


