GOOGONG SUSTAINABLE HOUSING INITIATIVE LAUNCHED

Queanbeyan City Council's Googong Sustainable Housing project was launched by Queanbeyan Mayor, Cr Tim Overall on Friday. This project provides a range of resources to assist people who are building at Googong to improve the sustainability of their new home, increasing their comfort, health, environmental quality, and reducing household running costs.

Free one-hour consultations with an architect and energy efficiency expert as well as workshops and online resources are now available through the Googong Sustainable Housing project website.

Free One-on-One Consultations

One hour one-on-one consultations with an architect and energy efficiency expert are available free of charge in either CIC Australia's office in Canberra City on Wednesday and Friday afternoons or in the sales office in Club Googong on Sundays. These consultations are available through to November 2014. Places are strictly limited and bookings are essential.

Free Community Workshops

All workshops are held at the RB Smith Community Centre, 262 Crawford St Queanbeyan. No bookings are required.

FROM YOUR LOCAL FIRE BRIGADE

With the bush fire danger period about to commence on 1 October 2014, it's a good time to prepare or review your bush fire survival plan for your household and prepare your home for the upcoming bush fire season. You should also be aware that during the bush fire period from 1 October 2014 through to 31 March 2015 a Fire Permit is required for burning activities. Fire Permits help ensure fire is used safely and minimise the danger to you, your property and the community. If you are planning to conduct any burning activities such as rubbish or pile burns, please contact the Jerrabomberra Creek Rural Fire Brigade on 0428 771 662 or Queanbeyan Fire Control Centre on (02) 6128 0600 at least a week before you plan to conduct your burning activity. Note that penalties may apply if you light a fire without a permit during the bush fire danger period.

In the past few weeks there have been several house fires in and around the Jerrabomberra Creek Rural Fire Brigade area. These fires serve as a timely reminder of the danger and destruction house fires can cause to life and property and the need to have effective smoke alarms for your home. A good rule of thumb is to check the operation and replace batteries of smoke alarms with the start and end of daylight savings. At the same time make sure everyone in your household is aware of what to do, how to exit your home safely and where to meet up outside of the home in the event of a house fire.
