

PAINT COLOURS

The use of whites and off whites on the walls gives a sense of lightness to the home. Introduce pops of colour through your soft furnishings, artwork and accessories. Corals, charcoals, greys and greens are also beautiful coastal colours, or even yellow, if you want a really bright and fun coastal scheme.



ACCESSORIES

Beach and coastal homes usually have a beautiful collection of trinkets, accessories and pieces of furniture that have been collected over many years and generations. LOOKING FOR SOME HEALTHY SUMMER SNACKS THAT WILL GIVE YOU ALL THE ENERGY YOU NEED FOR THOSE LONG DAYS AT THE BEACH? HERE'S ONE TO TRY!

ON WILL NEED

MOH

1 vanilla bean pod

155 g (1 cup) macadamia nuts

1/2 cup coconut oil

125 g (1/2 cup) coconut cream

1/4 cup raw cacao powder

9 teaspoons dried maca root powder

9 teaspoons (45 millilitres) rice malt syrup

Pinch of sea salt

1/4 teaspoon dried chilli powder

1/4 cup shredded coconut

STEP 1 Slice the vanilla pod lengthways, then scrape out the seeds using the back of a knife. Discard the pod and keep the seeds.

STEP 2 Roughly chop the macadamias in half, and place

STEP 3 Melt the coconut oil in a large mixing bowl over

STEP 4 Remove bowl from heat and stir through the coconut cream, cacao, vanilla seeds, maca, rice malt syrup, sea salt and chilli powder. Whisk until smooth.

STEP 5 Add half the macadamias and half the coconut. Stir through with a wooden spoon or spatula.

STEP 6 Line a baking tray with baking paper, then spread the mixture over evenly.

STEP 7 Top with the remaining macadamias and

STEP 8 Refrigerate until set, then break into twelve pieces roughly the same size. To store, layer the pieces in an airtight container, separated by baking paper. Keep refrigerated or - if like me you prefer it with a little more snap to it - in the freezer.
