Development update

Welcome to the first edition of the Golden Bay newsletter for 2019. It certainly has been a busy start to the year and it was great to see so many people at the recent Peet and Perth Scorchers Community Fan Day and the first two Golden Bay Car Park Café events.

We have a busy development program ahead. With the southern extension of Marillana Drive now complete, works to create the new foreshore access road and carparks are set to start in the coming weeks – this will facilitate construction of the new foreshore park anticipated to commence later this year.

The next phase of civil works in Stage 5 are anticipated to start later this month and are expected and be completed in Spring this year. As part of the infrastructure works for the stage, natural limestone boulders will be placed within the Landscape Protection Area along some portions of the boundary interface to provide stability to the dune. Limestone boulders have been selected to tie in with the natural theme of the area in lieu of retaining walls, in line with feedback received from the community.

In other news, the City of Rockingham has advised the period for public comment on the proposed amendment to the Golden Bay Local Structure Plan will commence on 8 March and conclude on 5 April. More information will be available at rockingham.wa.gov.au.

Growing green for Golden Bay

The Golden Bay Progress Association has been scouting locations for a sustainable community garden, with the corner of Aurea Boulevard and Arizona Parade identified as a possible option. The Association will inquire as to its viability and availability with the City of Rockingham as this site is part of the Tangadee Reserve.

Being close to the skate park and the school would enable passive surveillance and provide opportunities for local school kids to have tangible learning experiences of gardening.

It is estimated that around 80 people would need to be involved on a roster basis to maintain and harvest the garden and ensure adequate supervision and maintenance. That requires skillsets from gardening, to maintenance, handyman work - even administration and deliveries.

Local champion takes centre stage

It's been a busy few months for Golden Bay estate resident Rhys Mainstone who took on both the Busselton Jetty Swim and Rottnest Channel Swim!

Rhys became the first swimmer in the Busselton Jetty Swim's history to break through the 40-minute barrier, completing the gruelling 3.6 kilometre course in 39 minutes and 35 seconds, smashing the record by 29 seconds.

Two weeks later, Rhys took on the Rottnest Channel Swim solo and finished fourth with a time of 4 hours and 28 minutes, only 17 minutes behind the first place finisher.

Rhys and his partner Jessica have been living in Golden Bay for a year now and say it has been amazing.

"It's really good to get into a new community and have everyone be so welcoming. We joined the Secret Harbour Life Saving Club so we're really part of the community now."

"We also have a one year old daughter Isla and she's really changed my view on life. Having a young family has its challenges when it comes to finding time to train and work. But at the moment Isla is on a sleep schedule and we have been pretty blessed to have her sleep from 5pm until 7am most days."
