## Development update

Welcome to the spring edition of the Golden Bay newsletter!

It's certainly a busy time of year and we're excited to share some development updates with you.

We're pleased to advise that the Stage 4G civil works within the Seaside Precinct will commence this month, with some blocks available for sale just 245 metres from the beach. This will be the first beachside release in 18 months – so a very exciting time!

As this newsletter hits your letterbox, the construction of the new foreshore access road and carparks will be completed, and construction has commenced on the new Foreshore Park, which is set to be home to a nautical-themed adventure playground, enclosed toddler playground and scooter

and BMX tracks. Together with plenty of grassed and landscaped areas, an ocean lookout and direct beach access, there'll be lots for you and your family to enjoy.

Your Foreshore Park is expected to be completed in Summer 2020, so keep an eye out for further details as an exciting opening event is just around the corner!

As part of the most recent construction activity in Stage 5, works around the interface of the Landscape Protection Area were completed, as well as the delivery of the second residential stage in the area Stage 5B and the earthworks of Stage 5C. Please see the accompanying letter and link to our Frequently Asked Questions for further information.

We continue to liaise with the owner of the town centre site who is seeking a new anchor tenant for the development. We remain committed to updating the community with any new information as it becomes available.

As we head into the warmer months, keep a lookout for any announcements on the Golden Bay website around our exciting events and activities.
