A day full of family entertainment, food, drink, performance art and live music is programmed to pay homage to the past and give a contemporary nod to the legacy of comradeship, fun and creativity.

The Movida Estate Canteen Pop-Up Bar and Eatery will bring to life the glory days of the old Workshops canteen with some of Perth's most awarded culinary and hospitality experts recreating treats of the past. From gelato to coffee, cocktails to craft beer and Southern barbecue to noodles – this pop-up canteen has all of the foodie bases covered.

Helen offers an environment that nurtures the natural curiosity of children and encourages the development of their unique personality and character.




All family day care centres registered with Blue Lab work in partnership with many other organisations such as Sunsmart, Small Green Steps, and Healthy Meals-Feed Australia.
