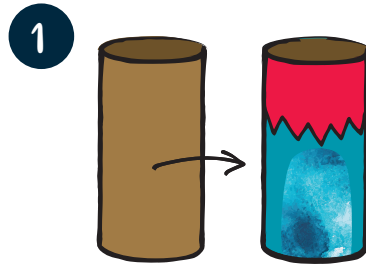


How to make a parrot.

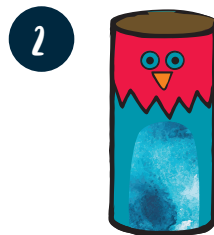
Arrr me hearties! Every pirate needs their trusty, feathery best friend. To make your own, follow the instructions below.

Ye be needing:

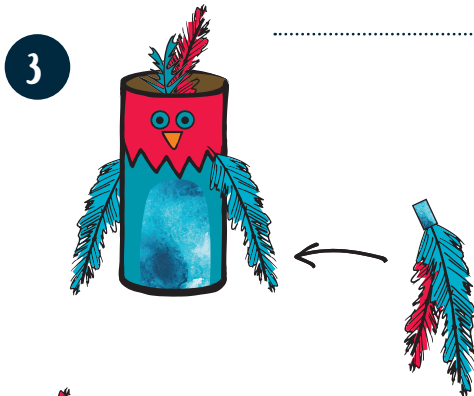
- 1 toilet paper roll
- Coloured paper in 3 different colours
- 2 circle stickers for eyes
- 6 feathers
- 1 pipe cleaner
- Scissors and sticky tape (or glue) for construction
- Markers for decorating
- Hole punch



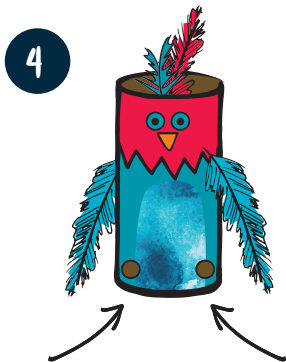
Wrap the whole toilet roll with the first coloured paper and tape or glue to secure. Then wrap a smaller section of paper around the top and tape to secure; this will be your parrot's head. You can also cut a zig-zag pattern into this to make it look more like feathers! Next, cut out a piece of paper for your parrot's chest; this should be slightly rounded at the top.



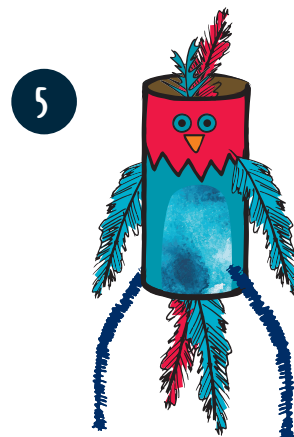
Use the circle stickers or cut out two small circles to make your parrot's eyes. Stick these onto the head, then draw on two dots to add pupils to the eyes. Next, cut out a triangle to use as a beak and secure below the eyes.



Your bird is ready for feathers! Tape a feather on each side for wings and 1 or 2 at the top for the crest. To make a tail, simply secure 3 feathers together at the top with tape, and then wrap the top of the feathers with paper to match your parrot's body. Next, tape onto the back of your bird.



Lastly, your parrot needs their legs! Hole punch both sides of the toilet roll, slightly towards the front of the roll.



Thread the pipe cleaner through the holes and secure to your wrist! Your parrot is now ready.
