Ahoy matey

– there's treasure to be found!

Shorehaven's new Treasure Island Adventure Playground is now open and ready for play!

Officially opened by City of Wanneroo Mayor, Tracey Roberts and Peet Regional General Manager, Paul Lakey on 22 June, the 2,150sqm playground is located at Waterfront Park and features an array of unique play equipment that has all been designed and made here in Western Australia – with a deconstructed ship wreck boasting an 8-metre climbing smoke stack, 12-metre whale shark, a rocking boat, a beach shack cubby house with story books, and an aligning stone to find 'treasure' using the Alkimos ship wreck.

Exciting treasure hunts provide a unique interactive opportunity as well as the chance for kids and parents to share in the play experience. Aspiring pirates can captain the ship, climb the smoke stack, escape down the slide, be swallowed by a whale shark, rest in a hammock, fire a cannon, swing on a rope and of course walk the plank.

There's also plenty of treasure to be found including a key, compass, telescope and a range of lost equipment as well as 20 secret starfish.

Development update

Welcome to the latest Shorehaven newsletter! There certainly has been a lot going on, within the community and in the local area.

It's been great to see so many people coming along to our recent events – from the more intimate community gatherings such as Brekky and Brews to the large-scale Shore Things events like the Shorehaven Seafood Festival which attracted thousands of visitors to the estate.

We are really pleased to have completed Stage 2 of Waterfront Park and delivered the Shorehaven's Treasure Island Adventure Playground which we hope will bring the families of Shorehaven a lot of fun experiences for many years to come.

Work to modify the design of the bottom terrace of Waterfront Park continues, which will help prevent the build-up of sand on turfed areas, and mark the park's completion. Leeward Avenue is also now open, providing another direct access point to Amberton.

Aegis Aged Care has commenced construction of its new facility at Shorehaven and completion is expected in July 2020. The aged care facility, located opposite Northshore Christian Grammar School, will provide 134 bedrooms and help to cater for population growth and the ageing population within the local and wider area. It is also expected to employ up to 50 staff.

It's also been exciting to see Stage 1 of the Marmion Avenue duplication works completed, and Stage 2 get underway. Those works, along with Yanchep Rail Extension will certainly improve amenity for local residents, reduce congestion and improve travel times.

We're looking forward to the community growing with the Wave release now available which includes a variety of clever two storey designs which overlook a future park and playground. Each package has a range of flexible floor plan options with stunning architecturally designed elevations and facades.

Northshore Christian Grammar School students, staff and invited guests – including the Federal Member for Pearce Christian Porter MP, Member for Butler John Quigley MLA and Wanneroo Mayor Tracey Roberts – joined Swan Christian Education Association Chief Executive Neil David for the ground-breaking ceremony to celebrate the start of construction on Stage 2 of the school.

Scheduled for completion in time for the 2020 school year, Stage 2 has been designed to cater for the growing school's future years 7 to 12 cohort. It includes two large buildings which will house state-of-the-art learning spaces designed to foster creativity, critical thinking, collaboration and communication. Between the two buildings will be an undercover multi-purpose sports centre suitable for both tennis and basketball.
