Open water swim

draws big crowd



Hundreds of visitors descended on Shorehaven Beach last month for the ninth round of the Swimming WA Open Water Swim Series.

Returning to Shorehaven for the fourth time in the event's 11 year history, race day presented challenging conditions for the 250 swimmers with a sizeable swell and strong current.

The action filled event resulted in great competitions in the water, with races of all distances, and categories – from under 15 boys and girls to Super Legends of open water swimming across 500m, 1.25km, 2.5km and 5km courses – fiercely competed.

There was plenty of fun had on the beach as well, with the swimmers, families and friends and spectators all enjoying the free beach volleyball, totem tennis and Swimming WA's inflatable obstacle course!

In the lead up to the event, Shorehaven also hosted free *Come and Try* swim clinics with renowned open water coach Ralph McManis. Ralph took novice swimmers through exercises that gave them a taste of the open water and tips to improve technique for open water swimming.

Marmion Avenue roadworks

The City of Wanneroo is making good progress on the upgrade of Marmion Avenue, which will see 11.5 kilometres of dual carriageway constructed from Brighton to Yanchep.

The project is being delivered in three stages, with work on a 1.2 kilometre section adjacent to Alkimos Vista currently underway. Construction of the balance of works from Shorehaven to Yanchep will follow, with the \$23 million project currently expected to be completed by January 2020.
