VISIT YANCHEP NATIONAL PARK IN BLOOM

It's wildflower season and the perfect time to visit your local neighbour – the Yanchep National Park.

The park will keep the whole family entertained with attractions including a koala enclosure, caves and walking trails, picnic facilities, Aboriginal education experiences, The Yanchep Inn, bird watching opportunities, a kiosk and camping facilities.

Now is a great time to visit with so many trails leading to gorgeous displays of wildflowers. You may find delights like the one-sided bottlebrush, Yanchep Rose and Enamel Orchid.

LOOKING FORWARD

As the weather heats up, so too is the activity around Yanchep Golf Estate.

Workers and equipment have moved in to start work on the new park on the corner of Linksman Street and Caddy Way. The area is currently looking a little messy but you'll soon see the form of the future playground taking shape. While the machinery is onsite, we ask you keep your distance for your own safety.

We'll keep you updated on the park progress via our newsletters and you're welcome to contact our Community Information Line if you have any questions.

We also ask residents to keep a distance from our fauna management specialists, who may be seen around the community assessing or relocating native kangaroos. Giving them space, allows our specialists to do their work and avoid

unnecessary distress to the kangaroos. Peet is continuing to work with Council, the community and others to develop an updated protocol for kangaroo management and we look forward to sharing more news about this soon.

The City of Wanneroo is continuing to progress the fencing dispute with Sun City Country Club. The matter will be heard by the State Administrative Tribunal in December and we hope for a satisfactory outcome from the independent umpire.

In the meantime, we hope you enjoy this wonderful time of year in this beautiful and special part of Perth at Yanchep. Front verges and gardens make a home feel welcoming and a neighbourhood look great.

As spring is the time when plants flourish, it's the perfect time for you to look at your front garden and verge and see if they need a spruce up!

Whether it's adding some natives or grass, clearing away weeds or loose materials, you can add value to your home through a great front garden and verge.

The City of Wanneroo recommends you keep verges clear of loose materials, fencing and rocks – or anything that may cause a hazard to yourself or other neighbours. You can also contact them if you'd like a list of plants suitable for nature strips or verges.
